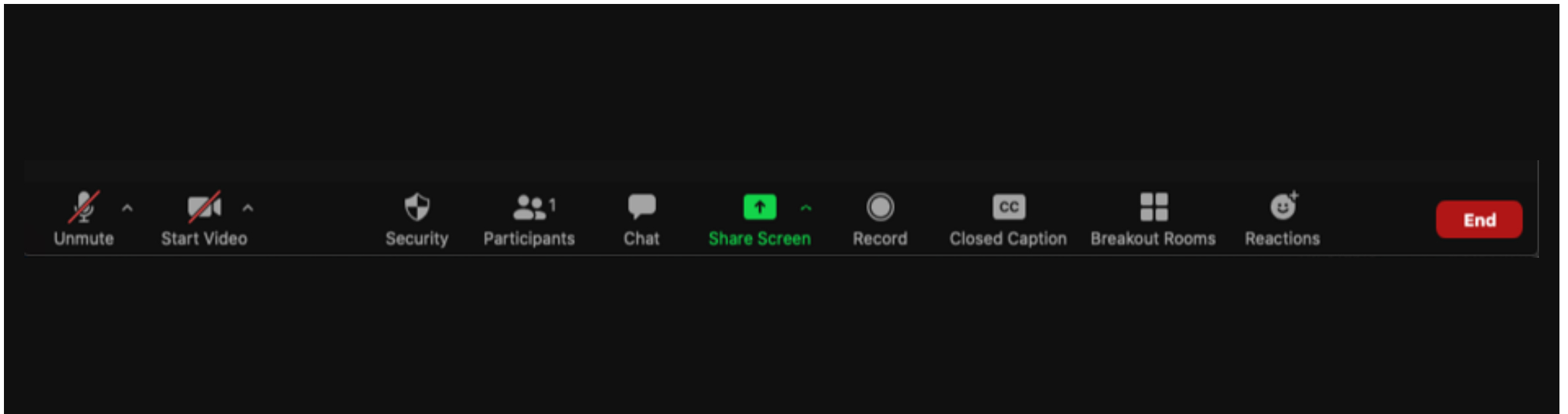
Useful for virtual presentations and multitasking

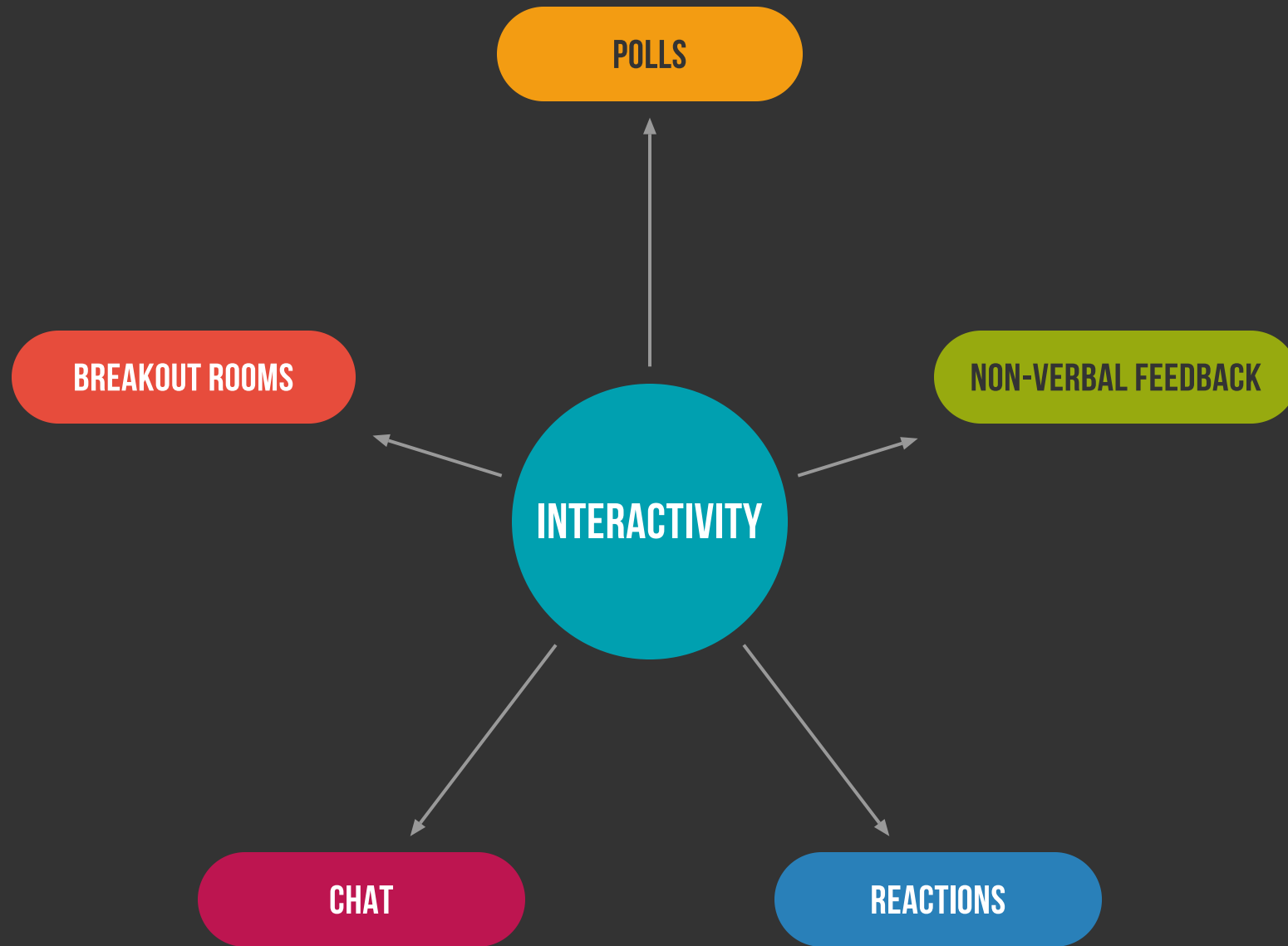

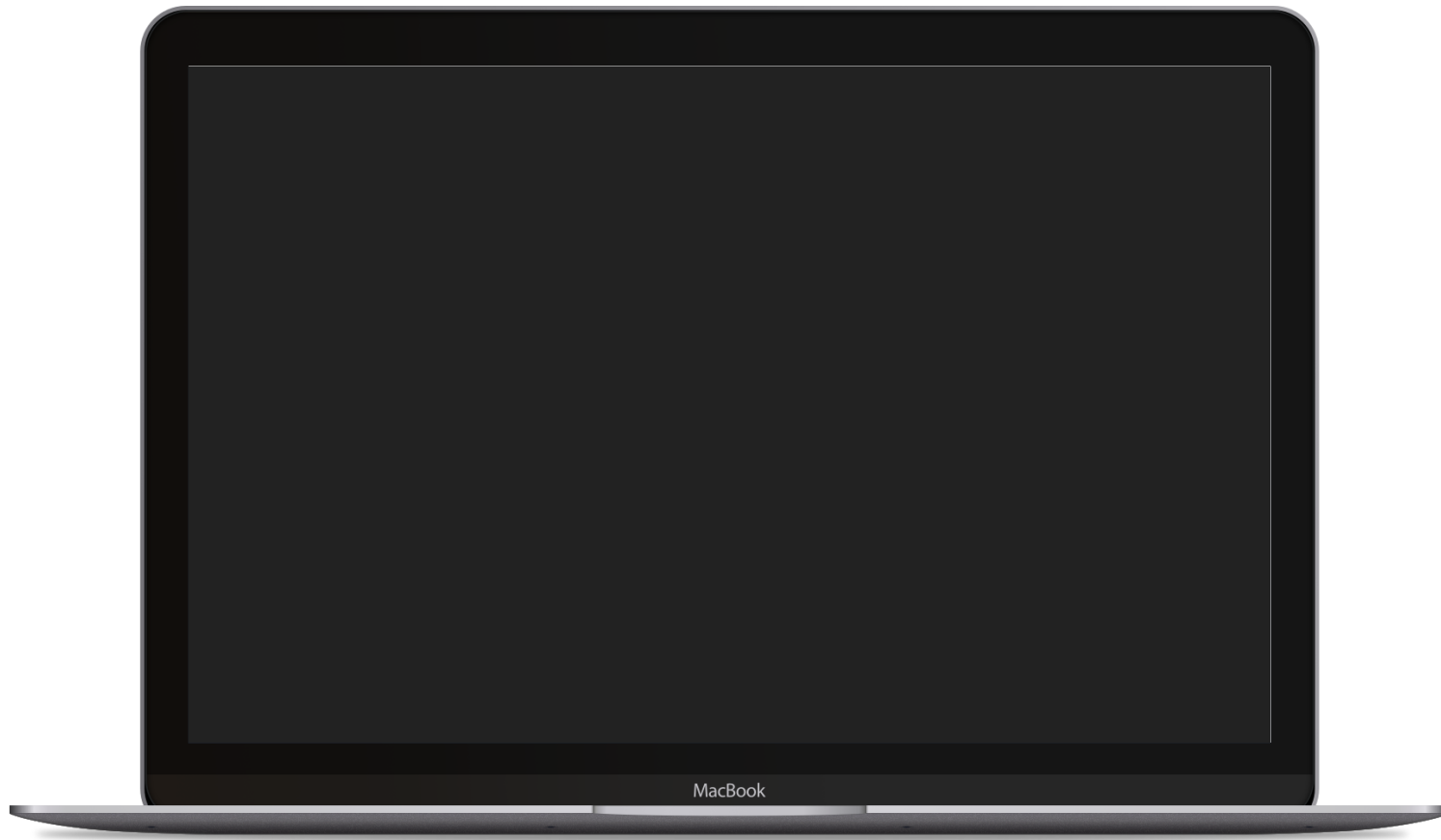

ZOOM INTEGRATION IN CANVAS



- **ENABLE ZOOM IN YOUR COURSE**
- **CHECK YOUR DEFAULT EMAIL ADDRESS ON CANVAS**

It should match your UBC Zoom email address
- **SCHEDULE & ACCESS MEETINGS**

All in one place in Canvas, even for your students
- **EASY ACCESS TO CLOUD RECORDINGS**

No need to distribute links or use local storage

ROLES & PRIVILEGES

HOST

There can be only one host.

There are certain actions only the host can perform.

ALTERNATIVE HOST

Assigned before the session.

Shares the same privileges as a co-host,
with one additional privilege:

can start the meeting without the host

CO-HOST

Assigned during the
session.

There can be multiple
co-hosts.

They share most of the
controls with the host.

HOST

- **CREATE OR EDIT POLLS**
- **ASSIGN SOMEONE TO EDIT CLOSED CAPTIONS**
- **END MEETINGS**
- **PROMOTE PARTICIPANT TO HOST OR CO-HOST**
- **ASSIGN PARTICIPANTS TO BREAKOUT ROOMS**

CO-HOST

- **CANNOT:** START A SESSION
 - **CANNOT:** CREATE BREAKOUT ROOMS
 - **CANNOT:** MAKE SOMEONE A HOST
- **CAN:** MANAGE ATTENDEES
 - **CAN:** MOVE SOMEONE TO THE WAITING ROOM
